New Chair for 0-25 VCS Forum		
Mike noted the NHS deficit and them clawing the money back, the impact that is having on the sector. The VCS need to be less reliant on statutory funding and come together and improve our partnership working to gain sustainability for services. Mike would like everyone who is struggling 'to come to us if you need help'		
Jess – Arts Development – suffered £10k cuts and can no longer be reliant on statutory organisations. A need for funding advisors to help organisations and trustee recruitment.		
Tracey – Dorset Mind – The State of the Sector, large opportunities for funding have become more difficult and there are huge differences between VCS and statutory organisations. The VCS have been let down and there are now trust issues ie. CAMHS beneficiaries and sustainability differences.
