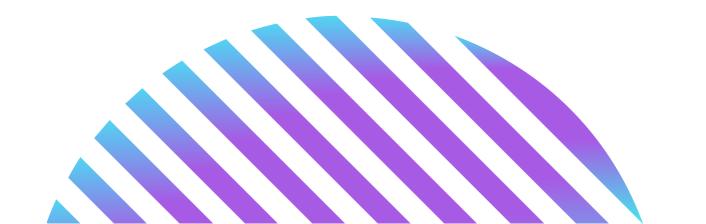

We work in partnership with over 250, 0-25 VCS services within Dorset and support over 60 Clubs and Groups. Gathering the voices of those we work with and allowing their voices to be heard is a challenge in Dorset. Many 0-25 organisations are asked to shape their provision using the voices of young people. In most cases they are acting on very few responses and shaping their service with a low response rate. This clearly is not good enough.

Dorset Youth's VoiceX aims to work in partnership with our 0-25 partner organisations within the Voluntary and Community Sector (VCS). We are actively engaged with many of our target audience already based within the local community, schools, organisations, clubs and groups. VoiceX is working with local organisations to gather the questions they want to ask, which will be categorised, simplified, actionable.

VoiceX is not just a survey capturing project, it is a personable service that interacts with all young people in Dorset so that their voices are heard, shared and then actioned on.

From April to July the VoiceX team have been carry out the survey at Youth Clubs, groups, schools and have attended HAF providers (Holiday activities & Food programme) during the Easter and summer Holidays.

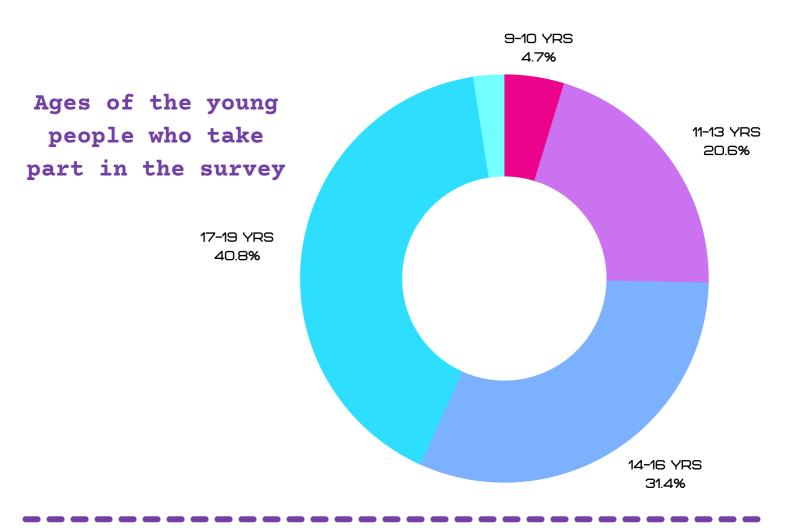


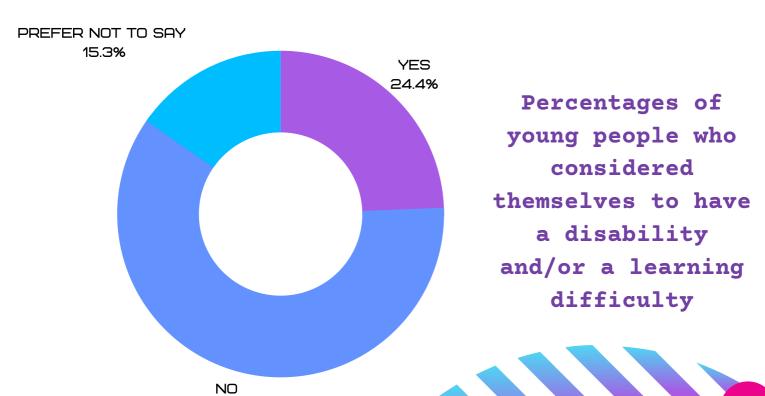






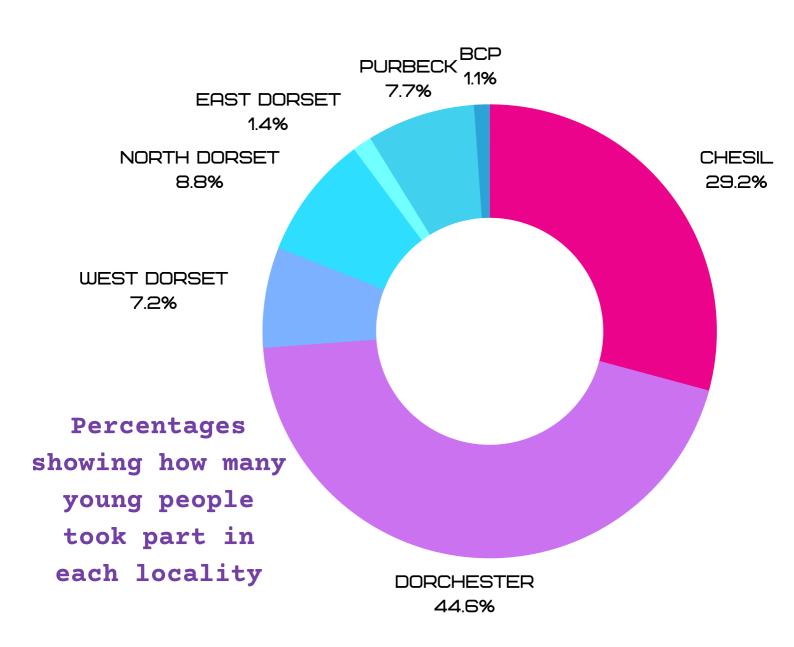
SNAP SHOT OF THE YOUNG PEOPLE WHO TOOK THE SURVEY

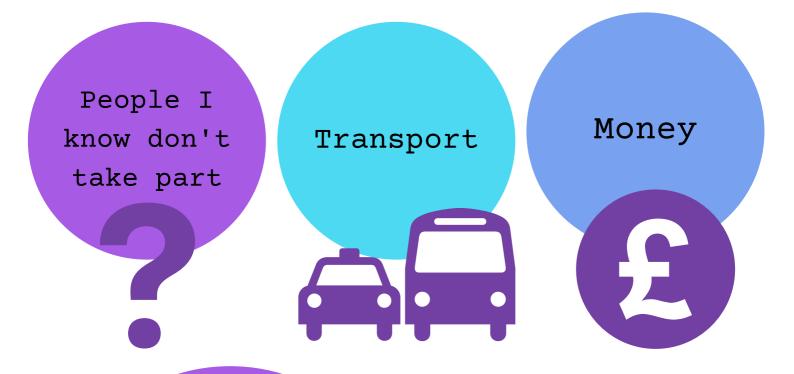

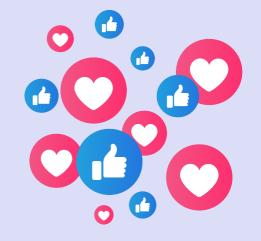

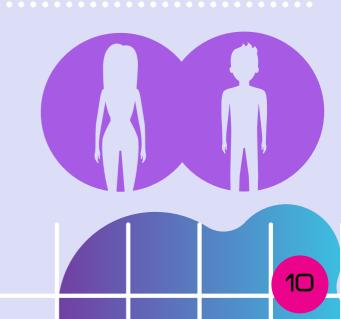

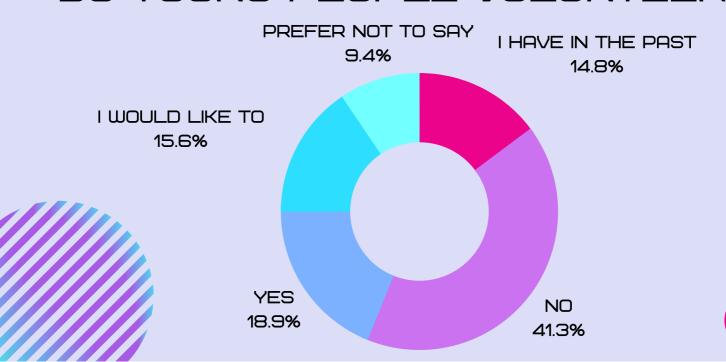


Agreed that they feel like they belong in their community



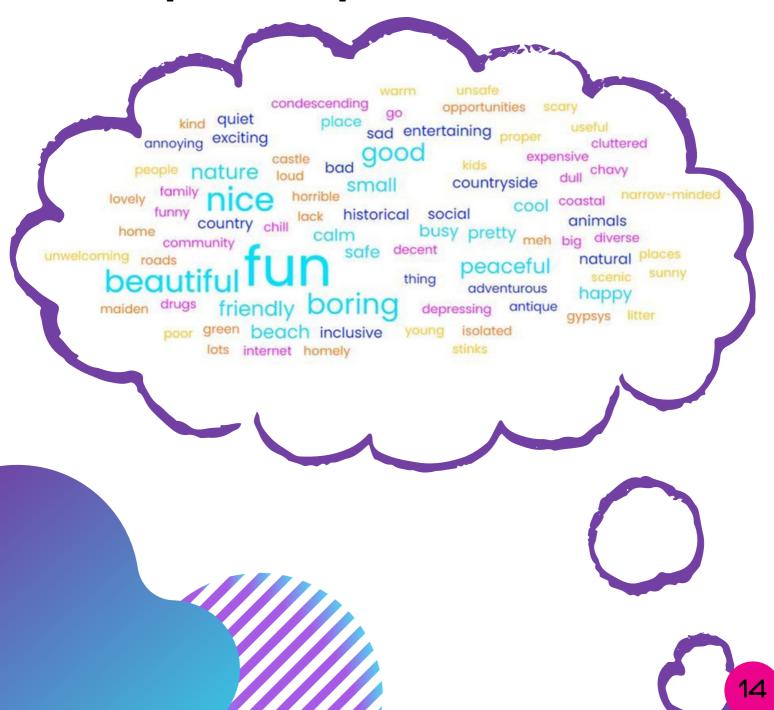

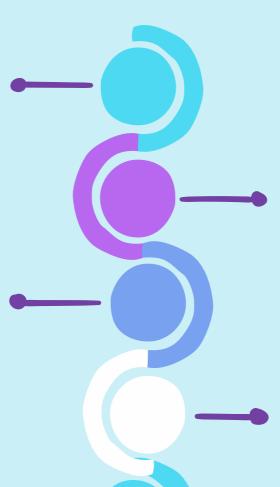
